2014-15 Registration & Scheduling

Scheduling planning sessions have begun. We are still accepting mulch orders in the school office through Thursday, March 27. After March 27, mulch orders will be accepted ONLY by phone at 859-392-8999 or on the Internet at www.hcmulch.com. Students can no longer hand in mulch order forms at school, but can still receive credit for phone or Internet orders. Also, all mulch money that has been collected needs to be sent into the school office by Thursday, March 27th, in an envelope with the student seller's name on the outside of the envelope.
