Drug Free Club of America

As you know Holy Cross High School is a charter member of the Drug Free Clubs of America. This program is a tool that will provide parents a comfort knowing your child is drug free, provide your child a proven tool to use to say NO, and to generate positive peer pressure when it comes to the issue of the use of alcohol and drugs. As a school we are integrating the Drug Free Club of America program and a form has been sent home to ask you and your child to join the program.

All students must send in the form expressing their desire to join the Drug Free Club or notifying school that you and your child have decided not to join. I want all of the students and parents to respond for two reasons. One, so that I can be assured that each parent was made aware of the opportunity and that this will continue or start a discussion between you and your child about the issue of alcohol and drugs. The second reason is to be able to give an approximate number of students to Drug Free Club so that they can prepare for their visit to the school.

We are extremely excited about this program it has been approved by the Diocese of Covington and is being implemented at other Catholic high schools in the Diocese. The PSAT is taken by all juniors and some selected sophomores. This standardized test provides practice for the SAT and is used for entrance in the National Merit Scholarship Program. Only students in grade 11 are eligible for National Merit consideration. A perfect score on the PSAT is 240. Scores are usually returned in mid-December. The PSAT is also one factor in the selection of nominees for the Governor's Scholar Program. The PSAT exam is Wednesday October 16th. Students planning to take the PSAT must register in the office and pay the \$14 registration fee by Monday, Oct. 14th.
